C.S.A. §2161 et seq. (must be submitted with application); (3) Be a United States Citizen; (4) Be physically and mentally fit to perform full duties of a police officer; (5) Be at least twenty-one (21) years of age; and (6) Possess a valid Pennsylvania motor vehicle operator license. Currently there is no residency requirements.

Successful applicants must also meet all the requirements of the Borough's Civil Service Rules and Regulations that will include a background investigation and if selected, be required to successfully pass a physical and psychological examination.

Completed applications must be filed by Monday, March 31, 2025 at 4:00p.m. There is \$45.00 application fee which will be return to the applicant on completion of the physical agility test. Applications must be submitted in person or mailed with payment.

Testing for the physical agility and written test is scheduled for Wednesday April 2, 2024 at the Borough of Turtle Creek Municipal Building, located at 125 Monroeville Avenue, Turtle Creek, PA 15145. Physical agility test at 10am, with the written test immediately after for those who pass the physical agility.
